APPLICATION OF STICKERS TO PADDING

Your lettering as shipped has the lettering sandwiched between a cardboard backing and a carrier tape.

Supplies needed:

Cleaning fluid (such as rubbing alcohol, Windex, etc.)

Tape measure, ruler, etc.

Masking tape

Squeegee or other hard, smooth piece of plastic

- 1. Lay padding down on flat surface.
- 2. Clean padding.
- 3. Place lettering on padding at desired location with the cardboard backing down. Use tape measure, etc. to verify that the lettering is square to the padding.
- 4. Place masking tape along one of the long sides of the lettering to secure in place.
- 5. Using the masking tape as a hinge, fold the lettering back so the underside is showing.
- 6. Remove cardboard backing, making sure that the lettering doesn't fold over and touch either itself or the padding.
- 7. While keeping solid tension on the lettering fold the lettering back over to apply to the padding.
- 8. Using the squeegee, rub over the top of the lettering to additionally secure the lettering to the padding.
- 9. Remove the masking tape.
- 10. Remove the carrier tape.
- 11. Use squeegee to work out any bubbles if necessary.
